


Expansion of the Medical Health Basket Services **10 Year Analysis**, **2010-2019**

Methodology



- Israel's National Health Insurance Law 1994 defines the health services that should be provided to Israeli residents ("Health Basket"). The 2nd addition to the law includes a list of the medical services the Israeli HMOs must provide. The budget for these services is allocated to the HMOs by the government via the Health Basket budget.
- The Committee for the Expansion of the Medical Health Basket Services (the "Basket Committee") is a public committee which convenes annually in order to evaluate and prioritize new technologies which may enter the Health Basket.
- This presentation provides an in-depth analysis of the budget for new technologies allocated by the government over the past 10 years.

Total budget in millions of NIS: 3.54 billion NIS* over 10 years



The Scarcity Problem: Technologies Rated Essential vs. Budget for the Technologic Addition to the Health Basket (in millions of NIS)




Technologies rated by the Committee as essential - rated A8-9 & A9

New technologies in the health basket: 29.5% are technologies without additional budgetary costs






Number of new technologies in the health basket, 2014-2019




















Expansion of the Medical Health Basket Services **5 Year Analysis**, 2015-2019












Total budget in millions of NIS: 3,541m NIS* over 10 years
